


## **INCLUDED PARTS**

NA-HCC1 steel clip




NA-HC6 cover





#### ! Caution

The cover increases the height of the heatsink by 7mm (from 165mm to 172mm) and the total width by 3mm (from 150mm to 153mm). Please make sure that your case offers sufficient clearance and that the cover doesn't make contact with any other components such as PCle cards!


If your CPU cooler is not yet installed, please first install the heatsink and attach the fan(s) to the heatsink as described in the cooler manual.









2 Attach the fixture to the heatsink using the steel clip.









Note that the steel clip must go underneath the second fin from the top.

3 Slide the cover over the heatsink until the magnets snap into place. Verify that the cover is sitting firmly on the cooler.
